The scientifically formulated Para Wood core ensures our floors can withstand external pressure to change.

Our floors are less likely than traditional flooring to expand, contract, or move when exposed to moisture, humidity, or temperature extremes.

From foundation to precious hardwood surface, each individual layer of our structured flooring is best-in-class.

Together the result is unparalleled.



Top Coat

Our finishes include a wide range of colors and stains which are protected with premium top coats of either 7 layers of scratch resistant UV-urethane or 3 layers of UV-oil.

Sustainable and Green

Our plank flooring is comprised of sustainable materials and is environmentally friendly. The sustainable core of our structured plank floors consists of a hardwood Para Wood with similar properties as oak.

Hardwood Surface

Produced from premium, sustainably sourced hardwoods, including European French Oak, our surfaces are available in thicknesses of 3.2mm, 4mm, or 6mm.

Para Wood Core

At the heart of every floor is our specially formulated pattern of Para Wood, a sustainable hardwood with characteristics similar to Oak, which gives the flooring its core strength and stability.

Foundation Layer

The bottom timber foundation layer adds additional stability and durability to the floor.

From Foundation

to French Oak Hardwood Floors

Sawyer Mason Flooring starts at the core: Para Wood, sustainable hardwood that shares similar characteristics with French Oak.

The density of Para Wood is the same as French Oak; however, this tree grows year round in ideal climates and quickly enough to offer a sustainable harvest. The Para Wood is prepped by being cut into short individual filets which are placed next to one another and hot pressed together perpendicularly to the length of the board to provide the most strength and stability while still allowing the wood to breathe with changes to the environment.

The core pieces are then split and sanded to the proper thickness and width. Sanding is done at an angle. This is a novel process that allows for a smoother finish and clean lamination to the face of the wood.

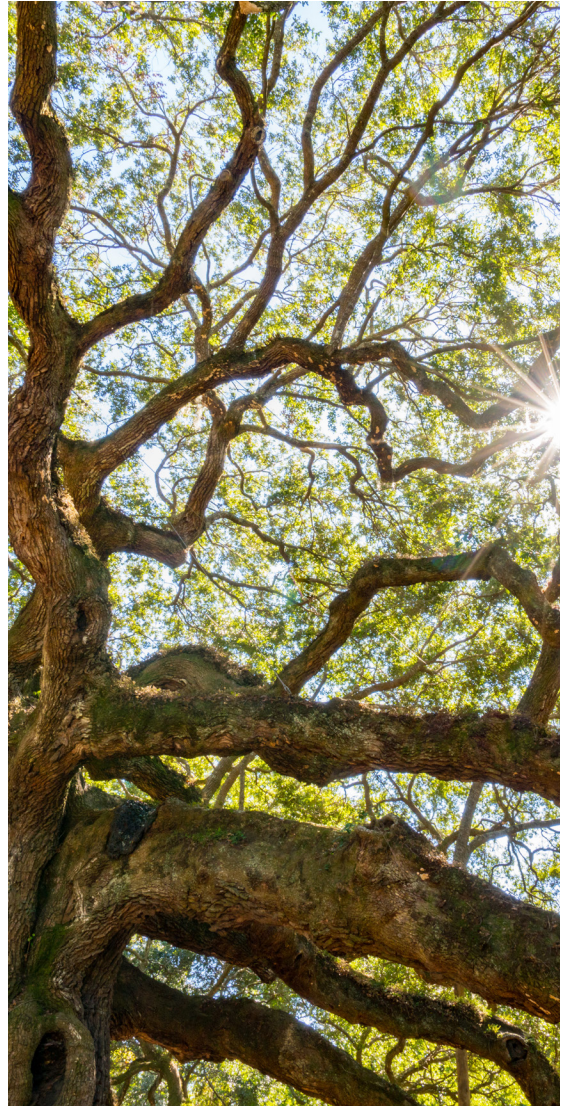
While the core is prepped, the face wood veneers, made from European French Oak, are carefully cut to the proper lengths and thicknesses for precise, consistent boards.

Subsequently, a process known as “blanking” is used to carefully sand and remove imperfections from the boards. The face veneers are then precisely cut to their final thickness of 3.2mm, 4mm, or 6mm, creating the thick, durable wear layer of Sawyer Mason flooring.

The core and the face are then carefully laminated together using a high-temperature hot press. Our glue produces zero emissions and no off gassing, so our flooring is completely within CARB compliance standards, and releases even less formaldehyde than a typical apple.

Our boards are hand-crafted with a unique style, featuring techniques like planer scraping, true hand scraping, hand brushing, and natural-looking cracks that give every piece its own character.

Before staining, the boards are carefully run through a spray center to prepare the surface. Reactive stains are applied and wiped off to create special effects, resulting in the distinctive coloring of our floors. These finishes and reactive color treatments make the flooring easy to maintain while enhancing depth and character.





The Lights

Light wood floors brighten any room. Sawyer Mason's collection of light-colored flooring ranges from warm, sandy tones to soft neutrals that blend light and dark hues for depth and contrast.

An escape from city life, this remarkable sanctuary sits within the historic Charlestown Navy Yard overlooking Boston Harbor. Light distressing softens the surface, while nuanced tones of wheat and light gray introduce depth and variation without disrupting the overall calm of the design. These subtle color shifts interact with natural light throughout the day, enhancing the floor's material presence while remaining architecturally quiet.

Together, the precision of the herringbone layout in the dining room and the understated finish create a flooring system that supports the architecture as a whole: balancing craftsmanship, texture, and geometry to deliver a timeless and cohesive interior environment.
